What to do with all those Thanksgiving leftovers---TRY THIS!!

Turkey	Potato	Casserole

1 onion-chopped

1# leftover-turkey-shredded 1# green beans-leftover

8oz. cheddar cheese-cubed

1 can cream of soup

8oz cheddar cheese-shredded

4c mashed potatoes-leftover

Heat oven to 350. Place turkey in an even layer on bottom of 9X13 baking dish. Top with a layer of onion and a layer of green beans so that the turkey in no longer visible. Pour the cream of soup over onion/bean layer, then sprinkle with shredded cheese. Stir together the cubed cheese and mashed potatoes, spoon over the top of casserole and spread out as needed. Bake for about 30 to 40 minutes until warm and bubbly all the way through.
