
On April 1st, Shirley will be preparing a pre-Easter dinner with baked ham and all the traditional trimmings. April birthdays will be celebrated at this lunch.

#### CRUST-

2c flour

1c margarine-soft

1/2c powdered sugar

#### FILLING-

1pkg cream cheese-soft

1/2c sugar

1t almond extract

2 eggs

#### FROSTING-

1 1/2c powdered sugar

1/4c butter-soft

1t almond extract

4-5t milk

#### ALMOND CHEESECAKE BARS

Combine flour, butter and powdered sugar, press into the bottom of prepared 9X13 baking pan. Bake at 350 for about 20-25 minutes or until golden brown.

Filling-in a bowl, beat the cream cheese, sugar and extract until smooth, add eggs and beat until well combined. Pour over crust and bake about 15-20 minutes or until the center is

ALMOST set. Cool

Frosting-combine all the ingredients until smooth and spread over filling. Store in the fridge.
