

TWO (OR THREE) DAYS AFTER THANKSGIVNG CASSEROLE

(use up all those leftovers)

Prepare a 9X13 baking dish, or larger, if you're going to feed a large group and have lots of leftovers.

Start by putting in a layer of dressing on bottom of baking dish. Shred about 2 cups of turkey and mix with a can of your favorite cream of soup,(do not dilute), when completely combined, spread on top of the dressing layer.

Next, using what ever you have for leftover veggies, combine with a small container of sour cream and a cup of your favorite shredded cheese, then spread on another layer to your casserole. Last is those mashed potatoes, combine a soft package of cream cheese with the spuds and spread on top of casserole. Add salt and pepper as you layer. Sprinkle a handful of shredded cheese and pop into a 350 oven for about 30 to 40 minutes or until all is warmed through.

This recipe is very easy to adjust the amounts you use and you can just about put anything you have available in the casserole.
