



CHEESY GARLIC FRIES IN FOIL

2T olive oil 4 cloves garlic-minced

1# red potatoes-cut into long wedges 1c shredded cheese-your favorite

2T sour cream 2T fresh chives or green onions-chopped

Salt and pepper to taste red pepper flakes-crushed-to taste



Preheat oven to 400 degrees, line a baking sheet with foil. In a small bowl, mix together oil, garlic, pepper flakes, salt and pepper. Place potato wedges in the foil-spoon the oil mixture over the potatoes. Fold the sides of the foil over the potatoes covering them completely and sealing the packet closed. Bake about 30 to 35 minutes or until are tender. Open packet and check for tenderness—sprinkle with cheese-and broil for 2-3 minutes-or until cheese is melted and potatoes are crisp. Serve immediately and garnish with sour cream and chives or green onions.

For a little more flavor you could add some crispy bacon bits.
