## HOLIDAY SWEET TREATS Oreo Truffles

2 (8 oz) pkgs semisweet chocolate chips
16 oz cream filled chocolate cookies-45ish 1 (8oz) cream cheese-soft

Melt chips over low heat, stir as needed. Crush cookies using food processor or rolling pin and bag. In bowl combine cookie crumbs and cream cheese, mix until well blended. Roll mixture into about 40 1-inch balls. Gently dip each ball into the melted chocolate and place on paper lined baking sheet and cool in fridge for about 1 hour.

## Fantasy Fudge

3c sugar
1 (12zoz) bag chocolate chips

3/4c margarine
1 (7oz) marshmallow cream 1t vanilla

2/3c evaporated milk
1c walnuts-chopped

Grease 9X13 pan. Mix sugar, margarine and milk in sauce pan over medium heat, stirring to dissolve sugar. Bring mixture to a full boil and cook for 5 minutes, stirring constantly. Remove from heat and add chips, stir until chips are melted, stir in the marshmallow cream until well combined. Add nuts and vanilla. Transfer to the 9X13 pan and smooth out. Let cool about an hour before serving.
