SUPER EASY POTATO CASSEROLE

1/2c butter-divided 1 onion-chopped 2 cloves garlic-chopped

16oz sour cream 2 cans cream of chick soup 8oz cheddar cheese-

shredded

1 30 oz bag of hash browns-thawed 1c bread crumbs 1T parsley-chopped


Heat oven to 350, in a skillet heat and add 2 tablespoons of butter, add the onion and cook for about 5 minutes, add the garlic, cook about 2 more minutes. Transfer to a plate to cool. In a bowl, combine the sour cream, soup, cheese, potatoes, and the onion mixture. Put into a 3 quart "greased " baking dish, cover and bake for 45 minutes. Meanwhile, place the remaining butter into a bowl and "nuke" for about one minute or until melted, add the bread crumbs and parsley. Top the casserole with the crumb mixture and return to the oven, uncovered, bake until the top is golden brown and the casserole is bubbly, about 25 more minutes.

HINT-add a couple of cups of left over meat (ham, chicken, turkey or whatever might be in the fridge) and you've got supper all in one dish. Might even have some leftover veggies you could add.
