BBQ Pork Sticks

3c cereal 1t mesquite chicken seasoning (or your favorite)

1/2c bbq sauce 1# boneless pork chops

3T apple juice 1/4c flour

Place cereal in a shallow bowl, mix in seasoning, set aside. In small bowl combine sauce and juice, set aside. Put flour on a plate, set aside. Trim all fat off chops and cut into lengthwise into half inch strips. Coat with flour, shake off extra, dip into sauce to coat and roll in cereal. Place on prepared baking sheet. Bake at 400 for about 30 minutes or until pork is tender and no longer pink. DO NOT cover or turn pork while baking, serve hot.

Cheese Sticks		
4c cereal	1/2t garlic salt	1/2t oregano
1/4c flour	2 eggs	2T water
	1 pkg mozzie cheese-8o	z (or your favorite)

Combine cereal, garlic salt and oregano in shallow bowl, put the flour into another bowl. In the third bowl combine the eggs and water. Cut the cheese into 16 (or so) sticks. Dip one stick into the flour, then the egg mixture and then the cereal mixture. Carefully dip again into the egg mixture and cereal mixture again to double coat. Place on prepared baking sheet and coat remaining cheese sticks using the same method. Bake at 400 for about 8 minutes. Serve with pizza sauce or salsa for dipping. (or if you prefer there is always ranch)

*REMEMBER-you can have your rent automatically paid each month using your bank account. If this sounds like something of interest to you, just come to the office and sign up, it only takes a couple of minutes.

*ALSO-a reminder-even though inspections are still a couple months out, it is not too early to start your "getting ready" process.

*One more thing-you MUST report all of your income to the office, it is the LAW, and if you don't you WILL be required to pay back rent.
