WHAT'S VALENTINES DAY WITHOUT CHOCOLATE??

Peanut Butter Chocolate Chip Cookies

1 1/2c flour	3/4t baking soda	1/4t salt
1 stick butter-soft	1c creamy peanut butter	1/4c sugar
3/4c brown sugar	2T honey	1 egg
1 1/2t vanilla	1c chocolate chips	

Heat oven to 350 and prepare two baking sheets. Whisk together the flour, soda and salt-set aside. Beat the butter, peanut butter, both sugars and honey until creamy and light. Add the egg and vanilla, mix well. Add the flour mixture in two batches, mixing to completely combine each addition. Stir in the chocolate chips. Make dough balls of about two tablespoons each and place on baking sheets. Using a fork press each ball down to about 1/2 inch thick, turn the fork the other direction and press again to make a crisscross pattern. Bake about 11-13 minutes, or until the edges are lightly browned. Let cool and enjoy—or eat warm, they are even better.

Oreo Pie

1 large pkg chocolate sandwich cookies	5T butter-melted	1c heavy cream
8oz cream cheese-soft	1/4c sour cream	3/4c powder sugar
	1t vanilla	

Finely crush 25 cookies, add the butter and combine. Press the cookie mixture into the bottom and up the sides of a buttered deep dish 9 inch pie plate. Place in the freezer while you make the filling. Using a mixer, beat the heavy cream until stiff peaks form, about 2 minutes. Transfer to a large bowl and set aside. Using the same bowl used to beat the heavy cream, combine the cream cheese, sour cream, sugar and vanilla, beat for about a minute. Transfer the mixture to the bowl with the stiffly beaten heavy cream and combine. Reserve 8 of the remaining cookies and place 9 cookies in the zipper bag and crush, add to the cream cheese mixture and fold to combine. Spread the mixture to the chilled pie crust and smooth the top. Put in the fridge for at least 4 hours. Just before serving press the 8 cookies flat into the top of the pie, slice and top with whipped cream and any left over cookie crumbs.



