


SUPER EASY CORNED BEEF AND CABBAGE USING SLOW COOKER

1 lg onion-cut into wedges	4 cloves garlic-smashed	1# baby potatoes
4 lg carrots-peeled/chunked	1 hd cabbage-cut into wedges	2 bay leaves
1 med brisket with packet	1 can beef broth	salt/pepper to taste

Place onion wedges and garlic on bottom of slow cooker, nestle the corned beef brisket on top of onions, sprinkle seasoning packet over meat and add bay leaves. Add the beef broth (or beer), then, add JUST enough water to cover the meat. Cover and cook on low for about 8 hours or on high for about 5 hours. About 2 hours before the cooking time is finished, add potatoes and carrots. About 45 minutes before serving, add the cabbage. Cook until the cabbage is tender and meat is easily pierced with a fork.

Transfer the meat to a cutting board and **slice against the grain**.

ENJOY!!! Any leftover meat is GREAT in sandwiches.
